INFORMATION AND RULES

1. ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST USE WOOD OR CHARCOAL FOR COOKING OF THE MEAT. Each participant must prepare the meat and two side dishes for judging. The meat will be provided by the BCCA. Side dishes must be provided by the participant. The entree will be judged on taste, flavor, texture, and presentation.
2. The meat will be delivered to the participants at the site of the cook-off. Only meat provided will be judged. No other meat will be allowed in the contest.
3. Water and electricity will be available at the site. Participants will need to provide all grills, tables, extension cords, fans, hoses, supplies, etc.
4. The contest will begin at 1:00 PM with the meat being delivered to contestants. Participants must have the entree plate ready for judging at 3:00 PM.
5. There will be only one winner. This will be determined by the scorecard from each judge. Each card will be reviewed by contest chairman once all cards are presented to contest chairman. Chairman will total the cards to determine the winner. Winner will be announced and recognized at the Showman Supper that evening. Results will be final. No appeals will be allowed. Scores will be posted for review.
6. Clean up will be the responsibility of each contestant. Trash cans will be available.
7. Grand prize to the winner will be a Big Green Egg Grill.
8. Cook Off will be held in downtown Homer near the Courthouse. Cost to enter cook-off will be \$100. This will include dinner for 2 at the Showman's Supper on June 18, 2011 at the Homer Methodist Church Fellowship Hall beginning at 7:00 PM.
