6. MISCELLANEOUS:

a. Fire/EMS: Purchase of LUCAS chest compression systems with the Opioid Settlement funds. Total Cost: \$66,196.60 - Chief Steve Nichols

Chief Nichols stated that the State of Georgia had awarded Banks County \$64,000 from a Opioid Class Action Lawsuit. He stated the funds had to be spent toward some kind of intervention to help with the opioid problem that we had. Chief Nichols further stated what we elected to do was purchase a LUCAS (CPR) device to put on med units. The funds would allow them to put a LUCAS on all med units and reserve trucks and staffed first line engines. The cost of all the devices was \$66,196.60.
