Taylor Griffith – 425 Evans Street, Homer – Stated he was appealing the application that was accepted because he believed that based on the type of hotel the application did not reflect the correct wording. He stated the application should say the use was "extended stay hotel" and not just "hotel."

Mr. Griffith gave various examples of how Home2Suites was advertised on the internet as being an "extended stay hotel".

Ch. Turk stated the criteria that was required to apply for a rezoning and that it was not up to one person to decide if an application was accepted or denied. He further stated that you cannot alter or refuse to take an application that the decision was up to the Board.

Comm. Gardiner stated it was not up to the County to have input on the application that was submitted.

Comm. Garrison stated it was up to the Planning Commission and Commissioners to make the decision on the application and not the Planning/Zoning Official.

Comm. Gardiner stated if the criteria was met, anyone could turn in an application.
