**HYDRANT METERS:**

RENTAL FEE: \$2.00 PER DAY OR \$45.00 A MONTH

DEPOSIT REQUIRED: \$1,000.00 for NON-LOCAL CUSTOMERS (CHECK ONLY, refunded with returned, undamaged meter)  
(Local meaning business location and business license issued in Banks County)

RATE: \$8.49 PER THOUSAND, for every gallon recorded by hydrant meter.

**NOTES:**

1. DEVELOPER IS REQUIRED TO FURNISH AND INSTALL ALL TAPS AND METERS FOR COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER SERVICES. WORK IS TO BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY BANKS COUNTY UTILITIES.
2. TAP FEES FOR ALL METERS GREATER THAN 8" SHALL BE CALCULATED BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER, BASED ON USAGE AND CALCULATED TO RESIDENTIAL USE (ERU) OF 350 GPD
3. FOR MASTER METERS SERVING MORE THAN ONE UNIT, THE FEE SHALL BE THE LARGER OF THE RATE SHOWN OR EQUIVALENT OF ¾" TAP FOR EACH UNIT SERVED BY SUCH METER.
